

Notice of General Election

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 7th day of November, 2006 at the usual polling places in the election precincts of Douglas County, Nebraska, a general election will be held. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for electing candidates for various offices. All races will not appear on every general election ballot as the candidates are nominated or elected by specific subdivisions, districts, or wards. At the same time, six amendments, two initiatives, and one referendum will be voted upon by the voters of the State of Nebraska. The Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of the amendments, initiatives, and referendum once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election. Issues Appearing on the General Ballot

**Douglas County School District 0010
(aka Elkhorn Public Schools)
School Bond Election**

Shall Douglas County School District 0010 (Elkhorn Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska, issue bonds of said School District in the principal amount of not to exceed Ninety-six Million Dollars (\$96,000,000) to be used for the purpose of constructing new facilities, constructing additions to and renovations of the existing school facilities, acquiring additional school sites, and providing the necessary furniture, equipment and apparatus for such school facilities; said bonds to be issued at such time or times as may be determined by the Board of Education, to bear interest at such rate or rates as may be determined by the Board of Education and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by the Board of Education; and

Shall the School District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the School District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the interest on and principal of said bonds as the same become due?
