

Notice of General Election

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 2008 at the usual polling places in the election precincts of Douglas County, Nebraska, a general election will be held. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for electing candidates for various offices. All races will not appear on every general election ballot as the candidates are elected by specific subdivisions, districts, or wards. At the same time, one amendment and one initiative will be voted upon by the voters of the State of Nebraska. The Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of the amendment and initiative once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election.
