

Notice of Primary Election

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, the 13th day of May, 2008 at the usual polling places in the election precincts of Douglas County, Nebraska, a primary election will be held. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Said election will be for nominating or electing candidates for various offices. All races will not appear on every primary election ballot as the candidates are nominated or elected by specific subdivisions, districts, or wards. At the same time, one amendment will be voted upon by the voters of the State of Nebraska. The Secretary of State will publish a true copy of the title and text of the amendment once each week for three consecutive weeks preceding the election. The following is a list of all offices and candidates that will appear on the primary ballots and a list of offices and candidates that will be automatically forwarded to the general ballot.
